


Policy: Health & Safety Policy

- 1) The Safety Management System (SMS) has the following aims and objectives:
 - a) Provide safe working practices
 - b) Provide a safe working environment
 - c) Set up risk control measures
 - d) Improve the SMS continually
- 2) We will achieve 'aims and objectives' through:
 - a) Set up controlled, documented procedures
 - b) Provide guidance for safe operations
 - c) Provide a safe work environment & reduce risk
 - d) Provide suitable & sufficient resources & training
 - e) Raise awareness about injury & incident prevention
 - f) Conduct shipboard & shore side drills
- 3) We will evaluate the effectiveness of the SMS by:
 - a) Shipboard & shore side audits & inspections
 - b) Reviewing the SMS continually to align with regulation & standards
