

Policy - Occupational Health & Safety (OH&S)


Responsibility:

- 1) The SMS & OH&S system have the following aims and objectives:
 - a) Provide safe working practices
 - b) Ensure the health of seafarers and shore staff
 - c) Provide a safe & healthy working environment
 - d) Set up risk control measures
 - e) Improve the SMS & OH&S system continually
 - f) Ensure our Managements commitment to Safety & improvements
- 2) We will achieve 'aims and objectives' through:
 - a) Comply with legal & other requirements
 - b) Set up controlled, documented procedures
 - c) Provide guidance for safe operations
 - d) Communicate effectively with all employees & contractors
 - e) Provide a safe work environment & reduce risk
 - f) Provide suitable & sufficient resources & training
 - g) Raise awareness about injury & incident prevention
 - h) Conduct shipboard & shore side drills
 - i) Make this policy available to any interested party

 - a) Shipboard & shore side audits & inspections
 - b) Reviewing the system continually to align with regulation & standards
