

Policy: Environmental Policy


All ship and shore staff shall implement this policy to ensure compliance with Pollution Prevention, Regulatory compliance and continual improvement.

- 1) Seaspan Ship Management Ltd. has three basic principles for the environmental policy:
 - a) to protect the environment;
 - b) to conform with our compliance obligations; and
 - c) continual improvement.
- 2) Seaspan Ship Management Ltd, implements a Safety Management System (“SMS”).
The SMS has the following aims and objectives:
 - a) reduce environmental risks;
 - b) continually minimize impact to the environment; and
 - c) continually reduce waste at the source.
- 3) To achieve our aims and objectives:
 - a) a culture ashore and on ships to comply with applicable environmental regulations;
 - b) take appropriate measures to minimize accidental oil, garbage, sewage, ballast, air pollution;
 - c) focus on usage of low-carbon energy by adoption of cleaner fuels like LNG;
 - d) drive innovation through the application of clean technologies;
 - e) work towards continual improvement;
 - f) install & maintain related equipment;
 - g) introduce systems to detect, report, correct and prevent any violation;
 - h) conduct ship and shore audits and inspections to review the effectiveness of its procedures.
